### New Safety Rules...

Thank you for welcoming me to your school it has been lovely to meet with you all. To help you get ready for next week, we need to tell you that school will look a little bit different. All our lovely staff will be here to help you learn your new routines.

I know your parents will have already shared with you how important it is to stay safe at this time because there is a virus in our community that can make people poorly. You have already learnt how to stay safe by washing your hands, and trying your best not to touch your mouth, nose and eyes and keep your distance from others. We have introduced some new measures in order to help you do this.



### Staying Safe - Wash your hands

Some children might feel a little bit worried and it is okay if you feel like this. (I think some staff are too, and maybe even your parents!) Remember to always tell a grown-up how you're feeling so we can talk about it.

When you come back you will be working and playing in a smaller bubble but they will be the same each day. Staff will explain everything to you and you will work, eat and play together.

Staff will greet you and direct you where to go.  
The steps below will help you get started really well....



Clean your hands with the hand sanitiser as you come in to your bubble



Take all your things to your bubble



Your teacher will show you where to sit and provide you with resources, just for you, and you can leave your bag and coat in your special space



Please only use your designated classroom toilets
