

English: Reading:

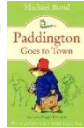


Guided reading "The Wild Robot."

Focus on fluency in reading, understanding vocabulary and comprehension, through using "Comprehension NINJA".

Writing:

- Persuasive writing: extending the range of sentences with more than one clause, using conjunctions, adverbs or prepositions, choosing nouns or pronouns accurately and noun phrases expanded by the addition of modifying adjectives
- Narrative: Write a "Paddington Bear" story in the style of Michael Bond with a focus on character, paragraphing, using *-ing clauses*, speech and adverbs.



Maths:



- Recognise the place value of each digit in a four-digit number and find 1,000 more or less.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations
- Round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000.
- Read Roman numerals to 100 (I to C).
- Assess "Times Tables Knowledge"

Science: Sound



- Identify how sounds are made.
- Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear.
- Find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.
- Find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it.
