Every child in KS1 is entitled to a free school meal, including trips.

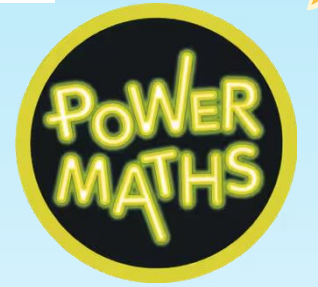

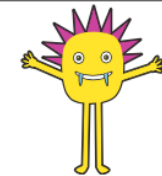

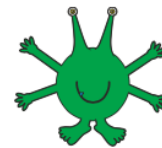
