

## English:

### Re-Think Reading:



Develop positive attitudes to reading and understanding of what they read by: increasing their familiarity with a wide range of books, identifying themes and conventions, discussing words and phrases that capture the reader's interest and imagination.

### Writing:

**Paddington Bear:** Write a story in the style of Michael Bond with a focus on character, paragraphing, using *-ing clauses*, speech and adverbs.

**Beachcomber (Poetry):** To write a poem about found objects. Focusing on expanded noun phrases (including prepositional phrases), commas in lists, poetic devices: listing, sibilance and alliteration.

## Maths:

### Multiplication and division:



- Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to  $12 \times 12$ .
- Use place value, known and derived facts to multiply and divide mentally.

### Length and Perimeter

- Measure in Km and m, calculate the perimeter of shapes.

### Textiles: Alice Kettle and Hannah Rae

We will explore a collection of sources to explore the work of Alice Kettle. We will discuss how the artwork makes us feel, create a scrapbook of our art ideas and then create our own painting and textile artwork inspired by Alice Kettle and Hannah Rae.
