History: Christianity in three empires (300-600CE)- this unit focusses on three cities and we read stories and examine the role of rulers in the spread of Christianity.

RE: Christianity 4: The Death and Resurrection of Jesus- We will read some "New Testament" stories and we will consider why these stories are important to Christians at Easter.

Maths: Fractions



- recognise and use fractions as numbers.
- recognise and show, using diagrams, equivalent fractions with small denominators.
- compare and order unit fractions, and fractions with the same denominators.
- solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities, including non-unit fractions where the answer is a whole number.

Physical Education:



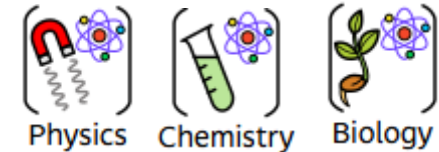
- OAA: Outdoor Adventurous Activities. We will explore the outdoors and develop a range of physical skills that cannot be achieved indoors.
