Reading: In reading, our class book is “Kensuke’s Kingdom’. For comprehension practice, we are using ‘Comprehension Ninja’ and previous SATS papers to look at a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts.

Writing: This half term, we will be looking at Wallace and Gromit’s Cracking Contraptions. We will be inventing our own contraption that can help us with boring, everyday tasks and creating an explanation text on how it works. Our texts will include: features of formal writing, expanded noun phrases to convey complicated information clearly and also the use of passive voice.
